- If using the optional base please decorate both the Candy Cane and the base

Please return the decorated Candy Cane to The Indian Trail Meeting Hall, at 113 W. Moore Street, on Monday, December 4<sup>th</sup> from 10 AM – 5 PM or Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> from 9 AM – noon for inclusion in the Candy Cane Garden.

Plan to attend the special evening "Candy Cane Garden Party" on Tuesday, December 5<sup>th</sup> from 6-8 PM. The event will feature music, refreshments, a visit by Santa and judging for best "Children's", "Nautical" and "Overall" themed candy cane. <u>New this year will be a live auction of five candy canes painted by local artists.</u>
